The helm area is large with an over-sized bench seat with additional storage. The dash is open with access to view all electronics. The owner added an e-box that houses the stereo but also is additional storage for charts or dry goods. The back of the leaning post is a tackle storage center. The in-deck live well can be used as an additional fish box. There is also another smaller live well in the aft section of the boat. The access hatch in the transom forward of the engines is where all the seacocks and pumps can be found. This boat is ready to go offshore fishing or a day of family cruising.
